

AcuPoint Analysis ANKLE PAIN*

(DESCRIPTIONS)

Point	Description
GB39	The width of one hand above and slightly forward of the crown of the outer ankle.
GB40	The width of one thumb directly in front of the crown of the outer ankle, in the valley that is just ahead of the crown.
GB42	On the top of the foot 1.5 cun from the margin of the web between the 4th and 5th toes.
LV06	7 cun above the inner ankle crown on the inside back of the tibia or shin bone.
SP05	1 cun in front of the inner ankle bone crown.
SP07	The width of two hands (6 thumbs) above the crown of the inner ankle, just behind the shin bone on the front of the leg.
ST36	The width of one hand (3 Cun) below the bottom of the kneecap, and the width of one thumb (1 Cun) toward the outside of the leg (direction of the small toe.) Found in the trough or valley where the two most prominent bones of the calf come together.
ST41	Where the foot meets the leg, in line with the separation between the second and third toes.
UB58	The width of two hands and one thumb above the crown of the outer ankle; and nearly in line with, but slightly behind, a line vertical to the outer ankle.
UB63	On the outside edge of the foot just ahead of the prominence ankle bone (direction of the toes) found midway between the toes and ankle.
K03	The width of two thumbs above the crown of the inner ankle, still on the inner side of the leg, but almost to the rear of the leg. Do not strongly stimulate this point after the third month of pregnancy.
UB60	In the hollow (or valley) behind the crown of the outer ankle.
