

## AcuPoint Analysis FLATULENCE\*

(DESCRIPTIONS)

Point	Description
C09	1 Cun above the navel.
K19	The width of 4 thumbs above the navel and one thumb to either side of the abdominal mid-line.
LI04	On the back of the hand between the thumb and index finger metacarpal bones. Find the spot midway on the bone that connects the index finger to the wrist. Sometimes this point is easy to find by squeezing two fingers together to form a small mound and marking an imaginary point at the peak of that mound. Then probe inward toward the main body of the hand, right on the bone.
LI09	3 Cun below LI11 (On the extreme end of the outer crease at the elbow) and on a line connecting LI05 and LI11.
SP07	The width of two hands (6 thumbs) above the crown of the inner ankle, just behind the shin bone on the front of the leg.
ST16	Directly above the breast bone tissue in line with the nipples, between the third and fourth ribs.
ST22	3 cun above the navel, 2 cun lateral from the midline.
UB43	3 cun from the spine midline, between the 10th and 11th thoracic vertebra. 5 cun above the waist line on a 'normal-waisted' person.

ESC04	RECTUM .F, PROSTATE GLAND .C, HEMORRHOIDS .F
ESC02	SMALL INTESTINES, APPENDIX, OMEGA 1, ALCOHOLIC POINT
EAH11	ABDOMEN, LUMBAGO (LUMBODYNIA) POINT, HEAT POINT
EAH12	ABDOMEN
EIH04	AUTONOMIC POINT, SYMPATHETIC POINT, URETER .F
EIC01	ANTERIOR PITUITARY, POSTERIOR PITUITARY, TRIPPLE WARMER, PROLACTIN
