
























## AcuPoint Analysis JAW/LOWER TEETH & GUMS\*

(DESCRIPTIONS)

Point	Description
FI27	Lower Jaw, Teeth and Gums. On side and top of toes.
FT27	Lower Jaw, teeth and gums. Wisdom tooth on the little toe toward the eye tooth on the big toe. Each tooth on the mouth is represented here. Top of the foot and hand.
C24	In the depression just below the lower lip.
EH15	Medulla Oblagata, Glossopharyngeal Nerve, Lower Jaw, Tonsil 3, Helix 4, Metabolic Regulation Point. Located on the 15th zone of the Helix.
EL03	Lower Jaw (Mandible), French Tongue, French Salivary (Parotid) Gland, Pons, Trigeminal Nucleus, Trigemal Nerve, Cheerfulness Point, Sleep Disorders 2. Located on the 3rd zone of the Lobe.
EL06	Master Point 9: Master Cerebral Point, Frontal Lobe, Optic Nerve, Master Omega Point, French Fear (Worry) Point, Psychomatic Point, French Analgesic Point, Chinese Nervousness (Neurasthenia) Point, Chinese Dental Analgesic 2 (Tooth Extraction Anesthesia, Lower Teeth). Located on the 6th zone of the Lobe. This master point diminishes nervous anxiety and negative, worried thinking. It relieves obsessive-compulsive disorders, psychosomatic disorders, and chronic pain.
EL07	Frontal Lobe, French External Nose, Prostaglandin Point 2. Located on the 7th zone of the Lobe.
ETF02	Master Point 1, (Shen Men), French Hip, Chinese Shen Men (Divine Gate), Pelvic Cavity, French Wonder Point. Located in the middle of the 2st zone of the Triangular Fossa. This master point alleviates pain, tension, anxiety, and depression.
LI01	Just behind the corner of the fingernail of the index finger, on the side closest to the thumb.
LI04	On the back of the hand between the thumb and index finger metacarpal bones. Find the spot midway on the bone that connects the index finger to the wrist. Sometimes this point is easy to find by squeezing two fingers together to form a small mound and marking an imaginary point at the peak of that mound. Then probe inward toward the main body of the hand, right on the bone.
UB60	In the hollow (or valley) behind the crown of the outer ankle.
