(DESCRIPTIONS)

Point	Description
LI04	On the back of the hand between the thumb and index finger metacarpal bones. Find the spot midway on the bone that connects the index finger to the wrist. Sometimes this point is easy to find by squeezing two fingers together to form a small mound and marking an imaginary point at the peak of that mound. Then probe inward toward the main body of the hand, right on the bone.
SP03	On the inside of the foot just behind the large bulging joint of the big toe. On the metatarsal bone.
ST24	1 cun above the navel, 2 cun lateral from the midline.
ST25	2 Cun from the midline at the level of the umbilicus.
ST37	The width of one hand and two thumbs below the bottom of the kneecap, the width of one thumb to the outside of the front (shin) bone, in the direction of the small toe.
UB25	1.5 cun from the spine midline, on a level between the 4th and 5th lumbar vertebra. Just above an imaginary line drawn between the mid-forearms. Easily stimulated with the Back-eze.
UB26	1.5 cun from the spine midline, on a level between the 5th lumbar and the first sacral vertebra. 4 cun below the waist line. Easily stimulated with the Back-eze.
ESC03	LARGE INTESTINES, COLON, HYPOGASTRIC NERVE
ESC04	RECTUM .F, PROSTATE GLAND .C, HEMORRHOIDS .F
FBL11	<i>Descending Colon. Bottom left foot.</i>
HI11	Ascending colon, Descending colon, Signoid colon, Small intestine and Transverse colon. Inside hand.
