

AcuPoint Analysis URINARY INFECTION*

(DESCRIPTIONS)

| Point | Description |
|-------|---|
| C03 | On the front center line of the body, in line with or slightly into, the pubic hair line. |
| LI11 | On the extreme end of the outer crease of the elbow. Bend your arm tightly and place your Acu-Ki on the end of the crease. Keep your massager in place while opening the arm and stimulate the point on your relaxed arm downward toward your forearm. |
| SP06 | The width of one hand (3 thumbs) above the crown of the inner ankle, just behind the shin bone on the front of the leg. |
| SP09 | On the inner portion of the leg, just below the level of the kneecap, in the concave depression just above the calf, in line with the crown of the inner ankle. |
| ST36 | The width of one hand (3 Cun) below the bottom of the kneecap, and the width of one thumb (1 Cun) toward the outside of the leg (direction of the small toe.) Found in the trough or valley where the two most prominent bones of the calf come together. |
| UB23 | 1.5 cun from the spine on a level between the 2nd and 3rd lumbar vertebra level with the waist. Easily stimulated with the Back-eze. |
| UB28 | 1.5 Cun from the spine midline, between the lower medial border of the posterior superior iliac spine and the sacrum. 2 cun above the point where the buttocks for a crease. Easily stimulated with the Back-eze. |
| UB32 | On the second posterior sacral foramen. 2 cun above the crease where the buttocks come together and 0.5 cun from the spine midline. A point easily stimulated with the Back-eze. |
| EIC02 | LUNG 2, IPSILATERAL LUNG, ANTERIOR HYPOTHALAMUS |
| EIC04 | LUNG, HEART .C, BRONCHI, TUBERCULOSIS POINT |
| ESC04 | RECTUM .F, PROSTATE GLAND .C, HEMORRHOIDS .F |
| EIH05 | KIDNEY .F |
| ESC06 | KIDNEY .C, URETER .C |
| ETF02 | Master Point 1, (Shen Men), French Hip, Chinese Shen Men (Divine Gate), Pelvic Cavity, French Wonder Point. Located in the middle of the 2st zone of the Triangular Fossa. This master point alleviates pain, tension, anxiety, and depression. |
| ECW08 | ADRENAL GLAND, LUMBAR SYMPATHETIC GANGLIA |
| EIH04 | AUTONOMIC POINT, SYMPATHETIC POINT, URETER .F |
