# AcuPoint Analysis

## DEMENTIA\*

(DESCRIPTIONS)

Point	Description
<b>K09</b>	5 cun above the crown of the inner ankle bone along a line one half the distance between the inside of the calf and the back of the calf.
<b>ST23</b>	2 cun above the navel, 2 cun lateral from the midline.
<b>ST45</b>	Just to the rear of the second toenail, on the side closest to the smallest toe.
<b>T02</b>	On the back of the hand behind the web of the fourth and the fifth finger and in front of the knuckle joints.
<b>T10</b>	In the depression made when the elbow is flexed, about 1 cun in back of the tip of the elbow bone.
<b>LI04</b>	On the back of the hand between the thumb and index finger metacarpal bones. Find the spot midway on the bone that connects the index finger to the wrist. Sometimes this point is easy to find by squeezing two fingers together to form a small mound and marking an imaginary point at the peak of that mound. Then probe inward toward the main body of the hand, right on the bone.
<b>LV03</b>	Two cun above the separation between the biggest and second toes, on the top side of the foot.
<b>C14</b>	2 cun below the bottom of the breastbone.
<b>G16</b>	1 cun below the area where the skull joins the spine (cervical atlas), on the spine.
<b>G26</b>	Midway between the nose and the upper lip.
<b>K01</b>	On the bottom of the foot, in the middle, just behind the ball (the most padded forward part).
<b>LU11</b>	0.1 Cun from the nail bed bottom corner on the top of the thumb. Between the nail and the first joint of the thumb, just behind the nail on the side farthest from the other fingers.
<b>T23</b>	In the depression at the outer edge of the eyebrow.
<b>EHX01</b>	Master Point 0, Point of Support, Solar Plexus, Umbilical Cord, Penis, or Clitoris, Sexual Desire, Bosch Point, Diaphragm, Hiccups. Located in a notch at the beginning of the Helix Root. This point brings the whole body toward a state of homeostatic balance
<b>EL01</b>	Frontal Sinus, Frontal Lobe, Rhinencephalon, Septum, Olfactory Lobe, Olfactory Nerve, Amygdala, Irritability (Aggression Control) Point, Chinese Dental Analgesia 1 (Tooth Extraction Anesthesia, Upper Teeth). Located on the 1st zone on the Lobe.
<b>EL03</b>	Lower Jaw (Mandible), French Tongue, French Salivary (Parotid) Gland, Pons, Trigeminal Nucleus, Trigeminal Nerve, Cheerfulness Point, Sleep Disorders 2. Located on the 3rd zone of the Lobe.
